Old Amsterdam

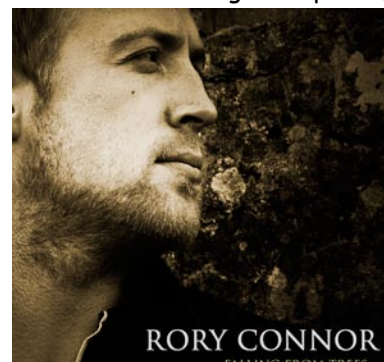
Mid March and spring can't be far away, though snow that's been around since a week before Christmas is still there in patches. My garden, shaded from the low sun is still knee deep in the white stuff, the wire netting fence broken down and any bare earth covered with rabbit droppings. Exposed bark has been stripped and fruit trees ringed above the guards by desperate rodents and deer. Nature wakes with lengthening days, alder and hazel catkins and clumps of snowdrops appear and bees make cleansing flights and collect the first pollen. It's good to see the peewits back performing aerobatics and pairing up. A mistle thrush sings out from the top of my neighbour Carol's sycamore tree, and she's been able to get out in her car this week for the first time this year! The river is running high with snow melt from Killhope fell, and though there's been little rain this month the ground is still wet. Its time get the greenhouse organised and seeds germinating again.

I have just been on a 'mini cruise' from Newcastle to my old stamping ground of Amsterdam with a friend. I lived there on boats and in squats in

the late sixties and early seventies and none of us get any younger. I went principally to visit Claire, who was a nurse when we met and made daisy chains in the Vondel park.. She has always been a kind and giving person and has for many years embraced the Bahai community in Amsterdam, but she didn't want to be where she was now. In hospital, in pain, riddled with cancer and reduced to 45 kilos. At least she's been able eat solid food again and is now back home to be cared for by her daughter Tahiri and friends, with her grandchildren around her. It was good to see my ex-girl friend Ella, who came to Alston with me 35 years ago, and has good and bad memories of that time. She has lived for many years happily now with sculptor and community artist Joseph, and she looked very well considering she has lung cancer, and has just had to get a power assisted bicycle (fiets!) to help her over bridges in that flat land. She showed me a picture tribute of her mothers life she'd published. Her mother died last year after a long life. Ella had seven siblings and her father was one of 27 in a catholic family. We are only passing through, trapped in our background, environment and genes! The rest of the trip was very enjoyable thanks to my lovely young companion. I wanted to show her 'my' Amsterdam, though it no longer existed. We did buy sourdough bread at the bakery of Paul Annee where I once worked, but the Cannabis Coffee Shops and the 'Ladies of the night' in the windows along the 'Waaletjes' were the main attraction. Dancing the night away to live music (a Hungarian band on the way over) on board on a calm sea was fun for us hedonists. Roll back the years! Only queuing at Tyne Dock for customs was wearying. One can travel around an EU without borders these days, but this is not Europe but an offshore island at war, floating in mid-atlantic and suspicious of foreign tongues.

Back at work its quiet but Ian Wilson from the Manufacturing advisory service has been in to assess our production process, and recommend efficiency savings. (So we can be meaner and leaner and more competitive?) Apart from running a tidier workspace.. I hold my hand up to being very messy.. his suggestion was to carry less stock... we do stock a lot of candles, enough to supply any order that comes in, but we could reduce our range. Ian Wilson, an engineer and former manager at Croppers paper mill, has an MSc in Lean Operations, and couldn't understand why I wasn't interested in making more profit, rather than just hoping to survive as a business, and working out how it can continue without me. Yesterday I walked from Ovingham along Whittle Dean woods where wild garlic leaves were sprouting, to call on George French, artist, philosopher and fellow pensioner at Stanholme, his wooden shack in its nature setting. He's looking out at the folly of world imprisoned in consumerism and capitalism, lamenting the lack of a green 'Geordie' vision or appetite for political radicalism. Recently, he left the woods to attend an anarchist gathering in a Newcastle pub, where all about beer was flowing (except on his table of fruit and water) Soon he had to retreat to the nearby woods and away from the pisshead Anarchists. However unrealistic his stoned striving for heaven on earth, he's an inspiration.

'Heroes of She' performed at the Town Hall recently. A good night and local duo Tom and Robin went down a storm with their Diango style improvisations. There's been a poor turnout for gigs here lately. Wonder if I'm getting out of touch. Next event is Wild Willy Barrett and Jinsky on May 1st. Meanwhile Rory who does much of the dipping here these days is making waves as a solo artist. He is playing gigs nearly every week, and next week is on at the Sage with Peter Tickell. 


- Candles are better displayed along a rail rather than on hooks, where the wicks may get tangled.
- Colours variable & subject to availability - nearest equivalent shade may be substituted. If you require an exact match please send a sample or quote a Pantone number.
